## My very own Chart Coloring Book

This little coloring book has been prepared with the hope that it can be an inspiration to our children, and provide them with enjoyable hours learning some of those basic Bible truths that have so thrilled our hearts.

While very elementary, because prepared for three to five year olds, it nevertheless has as its aim to familiarize them with the Chart of the Ages and its beautiful diagram of the plan of God.

We recommend the book being used in three ways as a teaching tool, while it is hopefully entertaining at the same time.

First, the little four-line poems on each of the pages are intended to introduce the concepts behind the pyramid figures on the chart in child-like language. We would encourage parents to take time to explain these concepts in increasing depth with their children.


Second, the progressive charts on the bottom of each page should help the child see how the various elements of history, Scripture and prophecy fit together, forming a beautiful picture of the whole of God's Plan.


Finally, the center page presents a large Chart with the random shapes only being sketched in with dotted lines. Enclosed with each book is a sheet of pyramids printed on gum-back paper. These are designed to be cut out and pasted in correct position. The large chart, thus providing a further enforcement of the overall or concept of the Chart-of-the-Ages.

If there should be any of you parents who may be unfamiliar with this chart, we cannot recommend too highly the book, "The Divine Plan of the Ages" which devotes an entire chapter to a detailed description of the chart, complete with unmerous Scriptural references to show the Bible backing for the concepts presented.

With these modest goals, we send forth this book, praying that the great Heavenly Father will enable each of us in our parental roles in instilling those spiritual ideas and goals which are so meaningful in our own lives.


